4. Extension of the Opportunity to Apply for and Operate a Storefront Cannabis Dispensary for the Cannabis Opportunity Reinvestment and Equity (CORE) Program

Recommendation: Review and provide direction regarding extending the opportunity to apply for and operate a storefront cannabis dispensary (the “opportunity”) from the 2021 Request for Qualifications (RFQ) Process for the CORE Program, which expires on April 1, 2026, by either: 1) taking no action and allowing the opportunity to expire, giving the next highest-scoring RFQ participant the opportunity; or 2) adopt a

Resolution: a) extending the opportunity by one year for a new expiration date of April 1, 2027; and b) extending the opportunity for any new applicant from five to six years.
