Issue Detail: The Council and the Sacramento Police Community Review Commission (“Commission”) has identified military use equipment oversight as an area requiring expanded public education and community input. Outreach planning is necessary to ensure the public is informed regarding military equipment policies, authorized uses, annual reporting, and opportunities for public comment.

Policy Considerations: California law establishes public transparency requirements related to military equipment use policies and annual review. Outreach planning should support accessibility, broad participation, and clear public understanding.
