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**Dissolution of the 2025 Community Police Review Commission Ad Hoc Committees**

**Description/Analysis**

**Issue Detail:** Per the City's administrative policy, ad hoc committees are to be dissolved within one year of creation with a summary report provided to the commission. At the April 14, 2025, Community Police Review Commission (Commission) meeting, the commission discussed the creation and scope of possible ad hoc committees. 2025 Commission Chair Kim Carter Martinez created the Engagement and Function Ad Hoc Committee, the Community Policing and Response Efficiency Ad Hoc Committee, and the Resource Allocation and Efficiency at Impacting Public Safety Ad Hoc Committee and appointed members to each committee.

**Policy Considerations:** Sacramento City Code section 2.40.160(A) states that city commissions may create temporary meeting bodies that are known as ad-hoc committees, and they are subject to the restrictions of both the Ralph M. Brown Act (Cal. Gov. Code § 54952 (b).) and the City's administrative policy pertaining to ad-hoc committees.

**Commission/Committee Action:** Ad Hoc Committees conducted work throughout calendar year 2025 and are scheduled to sunset unless otherwise directed.

**Rationale for Recommendation:** This action formally dissolves the Ad Hoc Committees as required by the City's Administrative Policy on Ad-Hoc Committees. A formal close out report allows the Commission to identify completed work products, capture pending recommendations, and determine whether additional follow-up or reassignment is necessary.
