### Description/Analysis

**Issue Detail:** City Code section 2.110.080 requires the Sacramento Community Police Review Commission(commission) to establish a regular time and place of meeting and to meet no less than nine times per calendar year. The meetings shall be noticed and held in accordance with the

provisions of the Ralph M. Brown Act (California Government Code section 54950 et seq.). The proposed meeting schedule is generally the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of each month at 6:00 p.m.

**Policy Considerations:** City Code chapter 2.110 establishes the Sacramento Community Police Review Commission and outlines the purpose, powers and duties of the commission. Section 2.110.080 outlines the process for commission meetings.

**Economic Impacts:** None.

**Commission/Committee Action:** None.

**Rationale for Recommendation:** As required by City Code section 2.110.080, the commission shall establish a regular time and place of meeting and shall meet no less than nine times per calendar year. Special meetings may be called by city staff or the commission. All meetings shall be open to the public in accordance with the Ralph M. Brown Act, Government Code section 54950 et seq.
