Description/Analysis

Issue Detail: On January 4, 2022, the Mayor appointed members of the City Council to serve on Council standing committees and various regional authorities, agencies, and committees as shown on the roster that is included as Exhibit A to the Resolutions included in the report package. The action requested is to confirm the Mayor's appointments for 2022.

Policy Considerations: This action is consistent with Council Rules of Procedure, Chapter 12, and is done yearly or when circumstances require a new or replacement appointee. The appointments must be confirmed by a majority vote of the City Council.

Economic Impacts: None.

Environmental Considerations: Under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) guidelines, continuing administrative activities do not constitute a project and are therefore exempt from review.

Sustainability: None.

Commission/Committee Action: None.

Rationale for Recommendation: Each year, or as needed, the Mayor appoints Councilmembers to serve on Council standing committees, and the various regional authorities, agencies, and commissions for the calendar year. This recommendation is consistent with that practice.
