**Background:** In 2017, the Office of the City Auditor issued an *Audit of the City's Medical Marijuana Dispensaries*. The report contained three findings and made 20 recommendations aimed at strengthening the monitoring of medical marijuana dispensary business operation tax payments, improving compliance with City Code, and enhancing recordkeeping. The Office of the City Auditor continues to follow-up on these recommendations every six months as part of the citywide recommendation follow-up process.

At the October 15, 2019 Council Meeting, the Office of the City Auditor received a request from the Mayor to provide an update on the 2017 *Audit of the City's Medical Marijuana Dispensaries* and provide potential next steps.
