## Description/Analysis

**Issue Detail:** In order to allow the City's Governmental Affairs staff, and contract state and federal legislative advocates, to be timely and responsive in protecting the City's interests at the State legislature and in Congress, the City Council is requested to review and approve the 2020 State and Federal Legislative Platform articulating the City's policies in its areas of interest.
