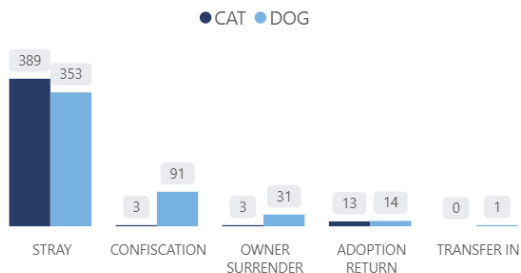

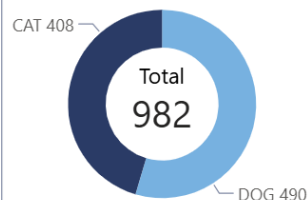

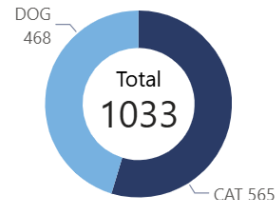
Shelter Intake by Animal Type

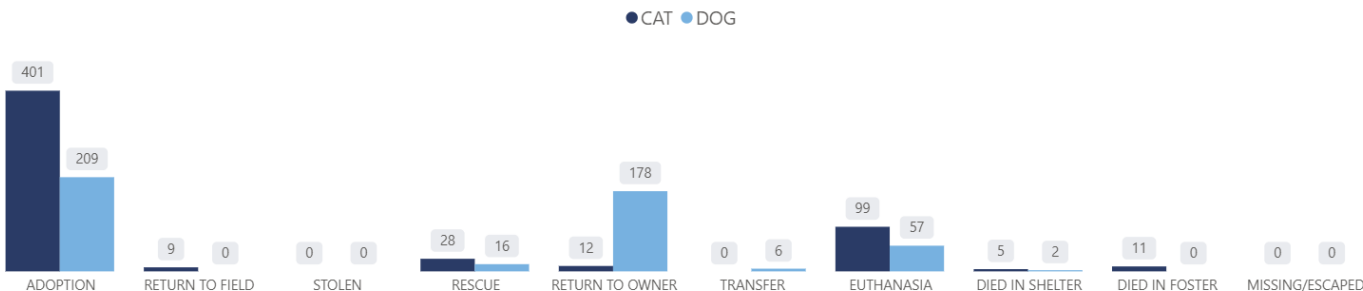
